Victoria Falls

The Zambezi, Victoria Falls, Mosi-oa-Tunya (The Smoke that Thunders), Zimbabwe

This 1.7km wide & 108m deep awe-inspiring waterfall on the Zambezi River, is located on the border of Zambia and Zimbabwe. Surrounded by a lush tropical rainforest, and home to a diverse range of wildlife, including hippos, crocodiles, and many bird species. The Zimbabwean side of the falls offers stunning views, walking trails, and adventure activities like white-water rafting, bungee jumping, and helicopter tours. The perfect vacation!

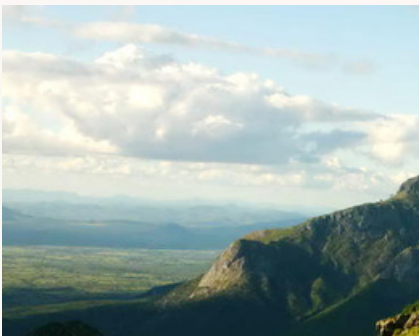


Kariba Dam



Kariba is a stunning destination! Located on the border of Zambia and Zimbabwe, it's known for its breathtaking lake and surrounding landscape. Home to the infamous Nyami Nyami snake, you will love watching a sunset over Lake Kariba, with the sky turning pink and orange.

A majestic African fish eagle soaring overhead, its wings spread wide. A herd of elephants making their way to the lake's shores, their reflections mirrored in the calm water and the Kariba Dam, a feat of engineering that created the lake, with its impressive structure and rushing water.



Nyanga



No camera will do justice to the beauty of this place other than your eyes. Located in the Eastern Highlands of Zimbabwe, Nyanga is a treasure trove of natural wonders. Nyanga is home to the highest point in Zimbabwe, Mount Nyangani, which rises to 8,504 feet. The rolling hills and mountains are covered in lush green grass and forests, creating a picturesque landscape.

It is famous for its stunning waterfalls, including the 762-foot Mutarazi Falls, Zimbabwe's highest waterfall. The sound of gushing water and the misty veil surrounding the falls create a mesmerizing sight, including the valleys, gorgeous, wild forestry offering stunning views.

Agriculture

The country's landscape nurtures some of the most sought after crops and plants, maize, tobacco, cotton & soya being the country's top grossing cash crops. Zimbabwe's soil is blessed with the ability to produce even in the toughest of conditions such as the recent climate induced elnino drought.

With 5 agricultural regions Zimbabwe's climate enables farming on a large scale from crop production, livestock production, forestry plantations, fisheries and aquaculture.

The country boasts of a vibrant and growing agricultural sector with various stakeholders including the government, local farmers, foreign investors coming together to boost agriculture production in the country. No wonder it was the bread basket of Africa!



Zimbabwe's Mineral prowess

Whichever district of Zimbabwe you travel to, you will likely come across some mining activity of some sort. The country is blessed from end to end with mineral resources, some you have never heard of before, from the platinum group of metals which are chrome, gold, coal, lithium and diamonds. With over 60 mineral varieties on its soils the country is engaged in intensive mining activities. The recent lithium burst has all the more made Zimbabwe a target for investors, and again with promising hopes of oil in the Mzarabani area. All eyes are on Zimbabwe.



Mining activities in Zimbabwe account for 12 percent of the country's GDP. Besides a myriad of challenges such as old technology and smuggling the country has the potential of generating US\$12 billion annually. Mining investors are flocking to Zimbabwe from mainland China, UK, Germany and the rest of the world.

INTERESTING!

Zimbabwe boasts the second largest platinum deposit and high grade chromium ores in the world, with approximately 2.8 billion tons of PGM and 10 billion tons of chromium ore.

According to the African Mining Market, Zimbabwe's lithium deposits are the largest in Africa and sixth in the world and could well meet 20% of the world's lithium demand. We are not running out of battery power anytime soon.
